Matrix The entire square was excavated by the backhoe prior to excavation leaving the locus highly disturbed. Close proximity to the army base indicates recent historic disturbance also. Excavation revealed matrix alternately loose to highly compact, light grey to dark brown in colour with many roots, much pottery and small to medium sized field stones. Rooftiles, tesserae, and some shell also present but little bone. Plaster fragments and kurkar fragments are also present, as are small lenses of yellowish sand.

Relations:

L06D1-001 continues into all four baulks and covers the fill of L06D1-008, L06D1-009 and L06D1-012. L06D1-001 also covers the rubble fill of robber trench L06D1-010. L06D1-001 came down on the grey material and cobblestone of F06D1-001 in the southwest corner of the locus. F06D1-001 is probably the subfloor and remaining cobbles of a cobblestone floor that was removed by the backhoe. F06D1-001 continues into the material of the baulk to the West - where it does not continue into AU/17, and into the baulk to the South, where it is the continuation of F06D1-002. To the North F06D1-001 is adjacent to the fill of L06D1-009 below F06D1-001 and to the East adjacent to the fill of L06D1-012 below F06D1-001. The relationship between these loci is too disturbed to be clear, although F06D1-001 may have extended over these loci. L06D1-001 was excavated down approx. 30 cm by backhoe prior to the commencement of proper archaeological excavation and is therefore highly disturbed.

Matrix Medium brown soil, highly disturbed by irregular backhoe surface scraping. Moderate amounts of pottery sherds, shell and crushed plaster. Small amounts of bone, Roman glass, Roman roof tiles and an iron nail (basket #06D1-0049). F06D1-002 was a cobblestone floor with a light grey hard-packed subflooring. Most stones (15-20cm in diameter) observed in NE quadrant of floor as others appear to have been scraped away by backhoe activity.

Matrix The matrix was dark, grey and very compact. As excavation continued it became less hard, but was still quite compact. There were many small kurkar inclusions, between 1 by 1 by 2 cm to 3 x 3 x 4 in size. Pottery sherds were common, and often showed signs of waterwear. Numerous roof tile pieces were also present. Pieces of marble wall facing, including several architectural fragments, were in the matrix. Bone was not very common.

Soil contained limestone fragments, some shells, and several scattered pieces of wall-plaster, several non-plastered mosaic tesserae (<50), and pottery. Within the topsoil, three pieces of unworked marble were found along the baulk of AU/17. F06D1-004 was a cobble floor. In the center-south, F06D1-004 had fewer cobbles and a large amount of roof tile fragments embedded in the floor makeup, suggesting remnants of a possible roof collapse. Special finds included one piece of red Attic figure, one marble architectural molding.

F06D1-004 covers and seals floor makeup L06D1-013 below.
